The Regular Meeting of the East Pennsboro Township Board of Commissioners was held on Wednesday, November 18, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. at the Community and Municipal Center, 98 S. Enola Drive, Enola, Pennsylvania.

Those present were: Commissioners – John Kuntzelman, President; Paul Hartman, Vice President; Charles Gelb, and George Tyson; John Pietropaoli, Township Manager; Henry F. Coyne, Esquire, Township Solicitor; John B. Owen, Codes Enforcement Officer; Mike Dobson and Andy Kirkessner, WWTP; Chief Todd Bashore, Police Department; and Erik Owen, Fire Marshal.

I. CALL TO ORDER

A moment of silent meditation was observed for the family of former Commissioner E. Thomas Fry, who passed away this week, and the victims of the tragedy in Paris, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

II. APPROVAL OF REPORTS

MOTION to approve the Police Report was made by Mr. Tyson, seconded by Mr. Hartman, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

III. BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR

Mr. Dale Crossland, 627 Mountain Road, thanked the board for their ongoing support of the Fire Department and announced on November 29, Northeast Fire and Rescue, along with Summerdale United Methodist Church, will be having a Christmas tree lighting at the firehouse in Summerdale at 6:00 p.m. On December 19th and 20th, Santa will be going around. Northeast Fire and Rescue also has 2016 calendars for sale.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL

MOTION authorizing payment of invoices and payroll pending review and signatures of Commissioners was made by Mr. Hartman, seconded by Mr. Tyson, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

Mr. Pietropaoli reviewed with the board the two lifts that are needed at the wastewater treatment plant. A 19-foot lift with an interior scissor lift is needed in the new headwork system to change grills, grates, and vents. Also needed is a 44-foot telescopic boom lift with an

outside platform to lift them up around the digesters' edges. The existing bucket truck only goes up 24 feet. The lifts were budgeted last year and they have been pricing used ones because they are not used heavily enough to justify spending \$100,000.

MOTION to approve payment to United Rentals for the purchase of one used JLG 44-foot telescopic boom lift in the amount of \$18,300, was made by Mr. Hartman, seconded by Mr. Tyson, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

MOTION to approve payment to United Rentals for the purchase of one 19-foot electric scissor lift in the amount of \$11,600 and, was made by Mr. Hartman, seconded by Mr. Tyson, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

MOTION to adopt Resolution no. 2015-14 honoring Nancy Otstot for her lifelong dedicated service as a school board director and community leader was made by Mr. Tyson, seconded by Mr. Hartman, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

MOTION to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 p.m. was made by Mr. Hartman, seconded by Mr. Tyson, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.
