The Work includes all materials, equipment, labor, and apparatus necessary for construction of the replacement of the storm and sanitary sewers and other miscellaneous work shown on the Drawings and as specified.

Each Bid must be complete and the right is reserved to reject any and all Bids and to accept any Bid deemed to be most favorable to the interests of EAST PENNSBORO TOWNSHIP.

Bidders can utilize the PennBid Program without any initial or recurring costs. A fee 0.25% of the bid total, capped at \$5,000, is assessed only to the bidder who is awarded the project.
