

# Gettysburg Area Dine Around History, Fun and Food....

- First stop enjoy coffee and pastry at Seminary Ridge Museum, Gettysburg. Three floors of exhibits connect individuals and groups to the dilemmas which led to the Civil War, provide a powerful and personal view of the battle's first day, and show the work of one of the battlefield's largest field hospitals.
- Gettysburg historic battlefield tour on board the coach. As soon as the guns fell silent, the Gettysburg Battlefield began drawing visitors. Today is serves as 6,000 acres of inspiration. Close to 1,400 monuments 1and markers dot the Battlefield's landscape.
- Luncheon at the historic Dobbin House for Soup and Sandwich Buffet - Four Score and Seven years before the Civil War Battle of Gettysburg, (1776), Reverend Alexander Dobbin built a house to begin a new life in America for himself and his family. Today his home, listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
- Elizabeth Ann Seaton Shrine - Elizabeth Ann Seton was a wife and mother, and then found herself a widow at just 29 years old in 1803. Despite the hardships that she faced, she went on to do amazing work, and eventually became the first American-born saint in 1975.
- 9/11 Firefighters memorial – Take a few minutes to view this 40 foot recreation of the 3 firefighters raising the flag at the 9/11 sight and other tributes to fire fighters throughout the United States on the grounds of the National Fallen Firefighters Memorial.
- Hollabaugh Bros. Inc – Take an in-depth look at what it means to be a fruit grower in the 21st century. Starting in the bee room, get a close look at how the agriculture industry has changed over the years. It's also good to review most of the basics, many people don't know how bees communicate with each other! See our working beehives up close and learn how we use different species of bees on our farm to do different kinds of pollination. Cider and dessert will be served and time for shopping in the market.
