# Southern Charm Tour: Historic Charleston & Savannah

October 29—November 4, 2017

## Day 1 ~ Sunday, October 29

7:00 AM Depart Harrisburg. Rest stops en route. Visit the Lewis Ginter Botanic Garden—Time to stretch your legs, explore and grab lunch “on your own” in the café. Overnight in Lumberton, NC. Dinner this evening on your own.

## Day 2 ~ Monday, October 30

Check out and head for a visit to Wadmalaw Island; driving down Maybank Highway is like taking a step back in time. A stop to see the famous Angel Oak Tree before we visit the Charleston Tea Plantation for a factory tour and a trolley tour thru the tea fields with a narrated history of the making of America’s only tea. Enjoy breathtaking views of the tea plants. Next, we will visit the Deep Water Vineyards and Firefly Distillery (Vodka) with a box lunch on the beautiful grounds in between tastings. Depart for Savannah, GA.. Check into your River Street Hotel and freshen up before dinner at Lady and Son’s Restaurant, after dinner enjoy the evening “On your own” (B, L, D)

## Day 3 ~ Tuesday, October 31

Full breakfast included. Enjoy some free time on River Street before boarding the Georgia Queen for a cooking demo and luncheon cruise. Learn how to make one of the most popular appetizers; enjoy the appetizer after your lesson. Then, you will set sail for a 1.5 hour luncheon cruise. After your cruise take a time to explore this historic area on your own. You are right in the heart of the city of Savannah, Georgia. The city was laid out in 1733 around four open squares, each surrounded by four residential (“tything”) blocks and four civic (“trust”) blocks. Additional squares were added during the 18th and 19th centuries, and by 1851 there were 24 squares in the city. In the 20th century, three of the squares were demolished or altered beyond recognition, leaving 21. In 2010, one of the three “lost” squares, Ellis, was reclaimed. Most of Savannah’s squares contain monuments, markers, memorials, statues, plaques, and other tributes. There is an optional 90 minute walking Pub Crawl. Savannah was named ‘The Most Haunted City in America’ and is well known for her ghosts and her good times. This Pub Crawl of Savannah combines them for a ghostly good time exploring the haunted pubs in the historic district. (B,L)

## Day 4 ~ Wednesday, November 1

Enjoy a light breakfast at the hotel and check out and depart for Charleston. Arrive in Charleston and enjoy a guided historic tour of beautiful Charleston, a city steeped in historical culture and heritage. Check into the hotel and freshen up, tonight we’ll have dinner in a downtown mansion. (B, D)

## Day 5 ~ Thursday, November 2

Full breakfast included at your hotel. This is a “day on your own” to explore this historic city. You are right in the heart of the city with a wide variety of sightseeing and dining experiences just steps away. (B)

## Day 6 ~ Friday November 3

Deluxe breakfast included, check out and depart for Richmond, VA. Upon arrival in Richmond, we’ll check into a local hotel and freshen up before your included dinner. (B, D)

## Day 7 ~ Saturday November 4

Buffet breakfast is included today. Check out. Enjoy a visit to the beautiful Maymont Mansion. Maymont was the 100-acre Victorian country estate of James Henry and Sallie May Dooley. The estate stands today as a remarkably complete expression of Gilded Age luxury and opulence. Depart for home in the afternoon. (B)
